PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Terrot HG 1928 350 cc sidevalve frame#89362 engine # 65304.S

The four stroke machines that Terrot produced in the early twenties had 350 cc JAP engines and archaic horizontal spring front forks.

They were fitted with Terrot's own 2-speed gearbox and chain-cum-belt transmission. Two versions were sold of this model G, the Sport and Touriste.

By 1925 it was time for a new model, and in the autumns the model H was introduced at the Paris Salon.

The first machines were still equipped with JAP engines and old type forks, but in the middle of November the modernized H appeared, with Terrot's own engine, Druid forks and Pilgrim oil pump.

This flat tank Terrot has full electric equipment and has been restored with care.
